

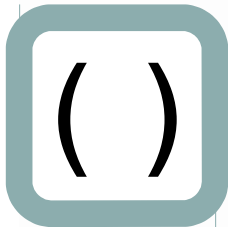
# HHS LIBRARY - MLA Citation Style Guide

## BASIC FORMAT



	Your name, your teacher's name, the course name and the date appear on separate lines in the upper left corner of the first page, double-spaced, above the title.
	The entire document is in an easily-readable typeface (12 point, Times New Roman, Arial or Calibri).
	The entire document is left-justified.
	The first lines of all paragraphs are indented ½ inch from the left margin, with all margins (left, right, top & bottom being 1 inch).
	The document does not have a title page. The title is centered at the top of the first page, in title case (the first word, last word, and important words in between), and is in plain text (not bold, underlined or italicized).
	The document is consecutively page numbered (Insert Menu then Click on Page Number). Page numbers appear in the upper right-hand corner of the page, ½ inch from the top, flush with the right margin, with your last name in front of the number.
	All abbreviations used are consistent with the 8th edition (2016) of the MLA manual.

## PARENTHETICAL CITATIONS



	All sources cited in the paper are included in the Works Cited.
	All parenthetical citations are formatted correctly and include a page number (if print) OR author name or title of article (in quotation marks if electronic).
	All quotations are formatted correctly.
	All prose quotations 4 lines or less are within quotation marks. All verse quotes 3 lines or less are within quotations marks.
	All prose quotes more than 4 lines and verse quotes more than 3 lines are formatted as block quotes WITHOUT any punctuation marks.
	All quotes of dialogue between two or more characters in a play are formatted as block quotes with the character's names in all CAPS.

## WORKS CITED



	All sources included in the Works Cited are also parenthetically cited in the paper.
	The Works Cited section starts on a separate page.
	All Works Cited are listed alphabetically by author's last name or first portion of entry.
	Works Cited are formatted with a hanging indent.
	Works Cited are double spaced within and between citations.
